Dancers 7 to 12 with no pointe experience audition at 11:30 and dancers over 12 or with pointe experience audition at 12:00. We will need your Nutcracker Performance Agreement that day. The agreement tells us that you know the rules and agree to be present the dates of the show and important rehearsals. Dancers can be added to the cast later, but dancers auditioning with their form will get cast in the first round of casting. Annual Registration Day is taking place on the 28th as well, so you will be able to get registered for fall while your dancers auditions!!
