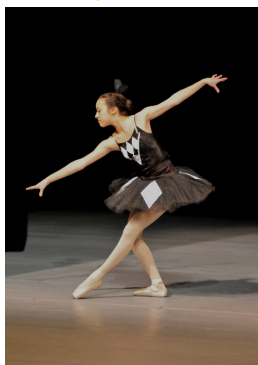

### Nutcracker Auditions

Mark your calendars for August 26th. Not only is it our annual registration day, but it will also be the Nutcracker Auditions. Auditions will be held between 11:30 and 12:30 in Studio A. Dancers who are 7 years old by the 26th or are placed in 1B for the fall are eligible for parts in the 2011 Nutcracker. Last year we had a record turn

out for dancers who wished to participate in the Nutcracker, so we highly encourage you to attend this audition if possible. If for any reason you are out of town and are unable to attend we simply need a Nutcracker Performance Agreement signed and turned in prior to the 26th. You may mail this in to our PO Box during the sum-
